

Egyptians used
hieroglyphs for writing.

- Each symbol is a letter or sound.
- Ancient Egyptians wrote on paper made from the papyrus plant.
- Using hieroglyphs is a very slow way to write.
- The Nile is the longest river in the world.
- Bread rotted the Ancient Egyptians' teeth.
- Today there are still over 80 pyramids in Egypt.
- King Khufu built the Great Pyramid at Giza.
- Ancient Egyptian children under the age of 11 didn't wear any clothes.
- Tutankhamun is the most famous pharaoh. His tomb and its amazing treasures were discovered in the Valley of the Kings in 1922.
