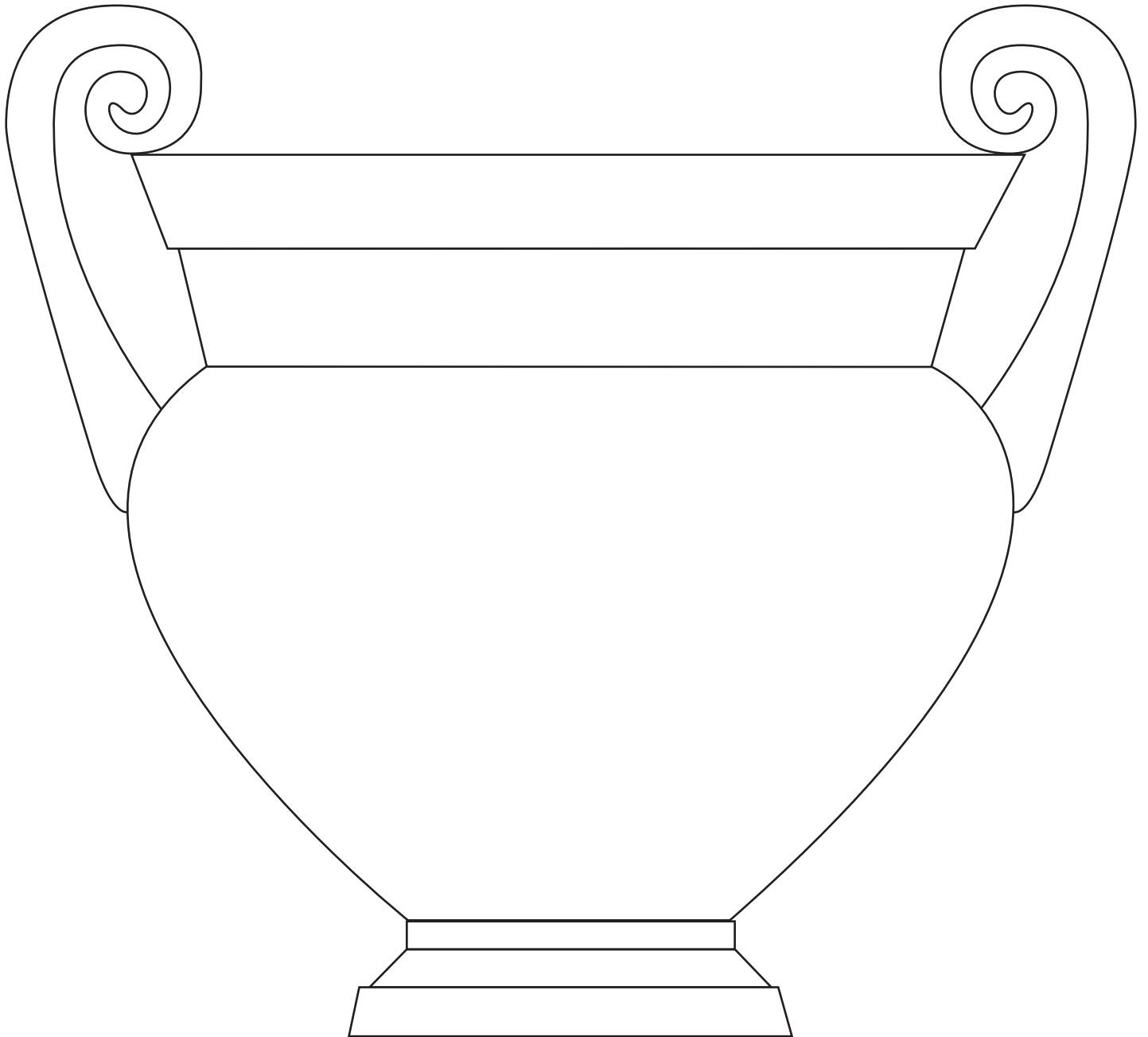

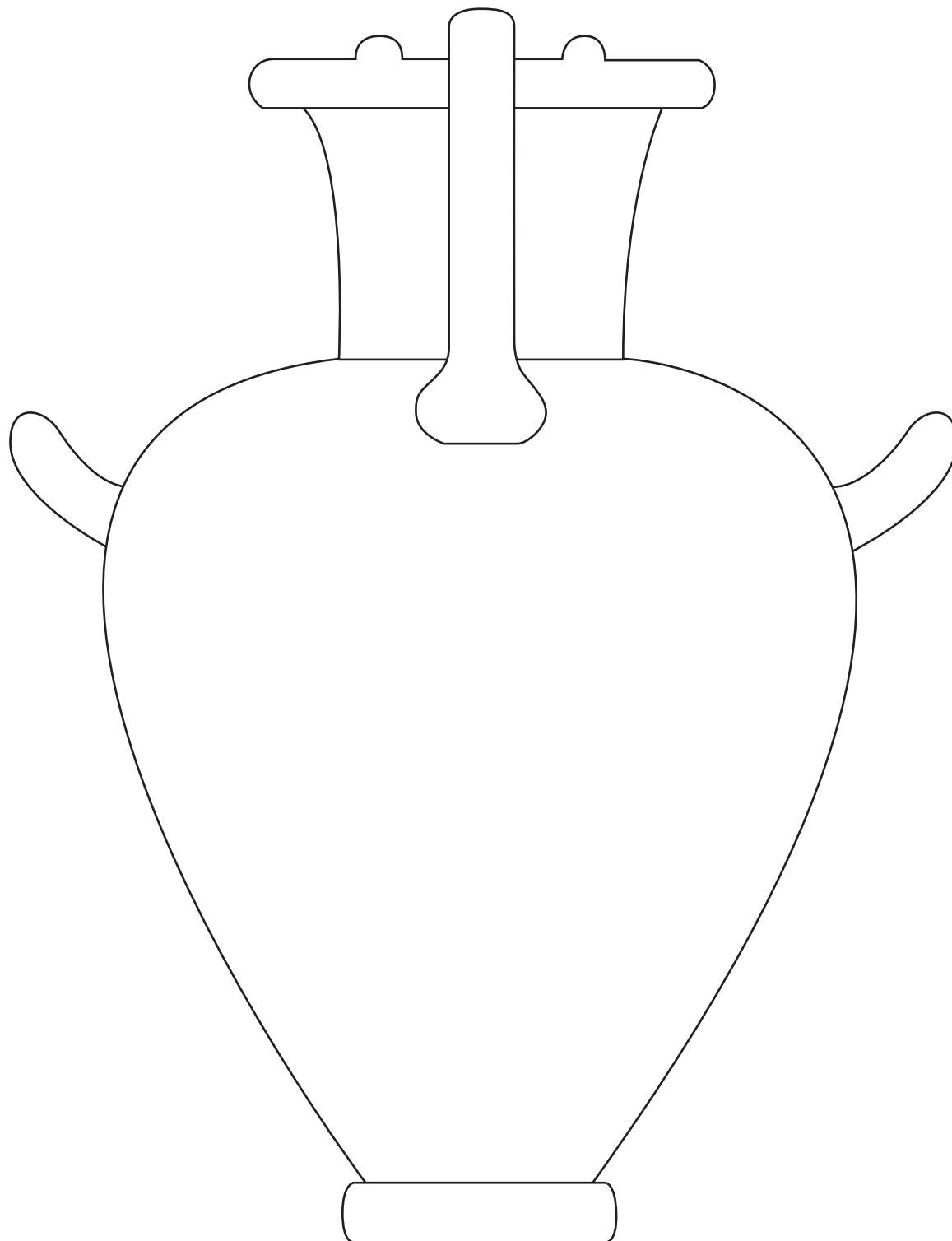
Krater Vase

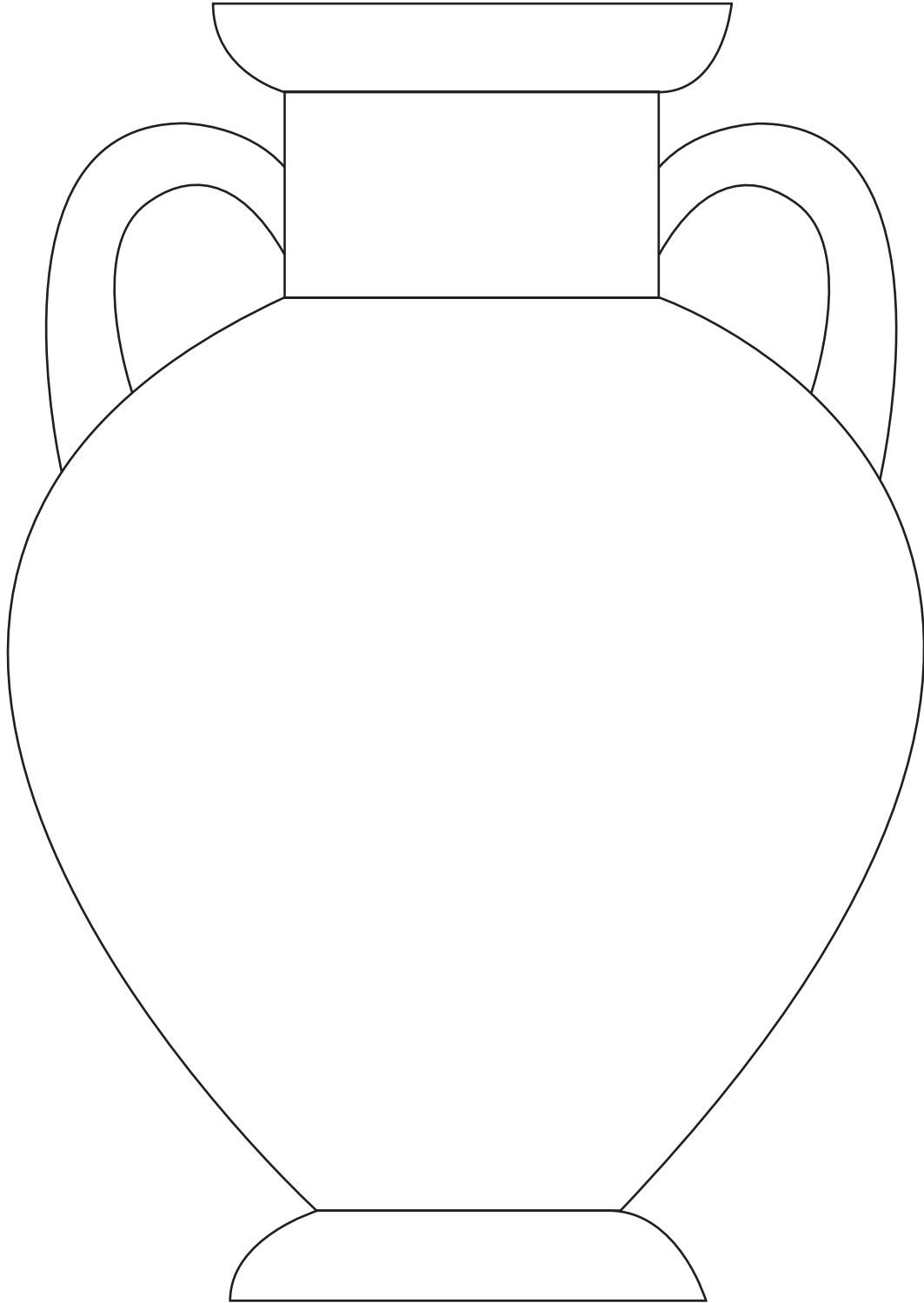
Hydria Vase

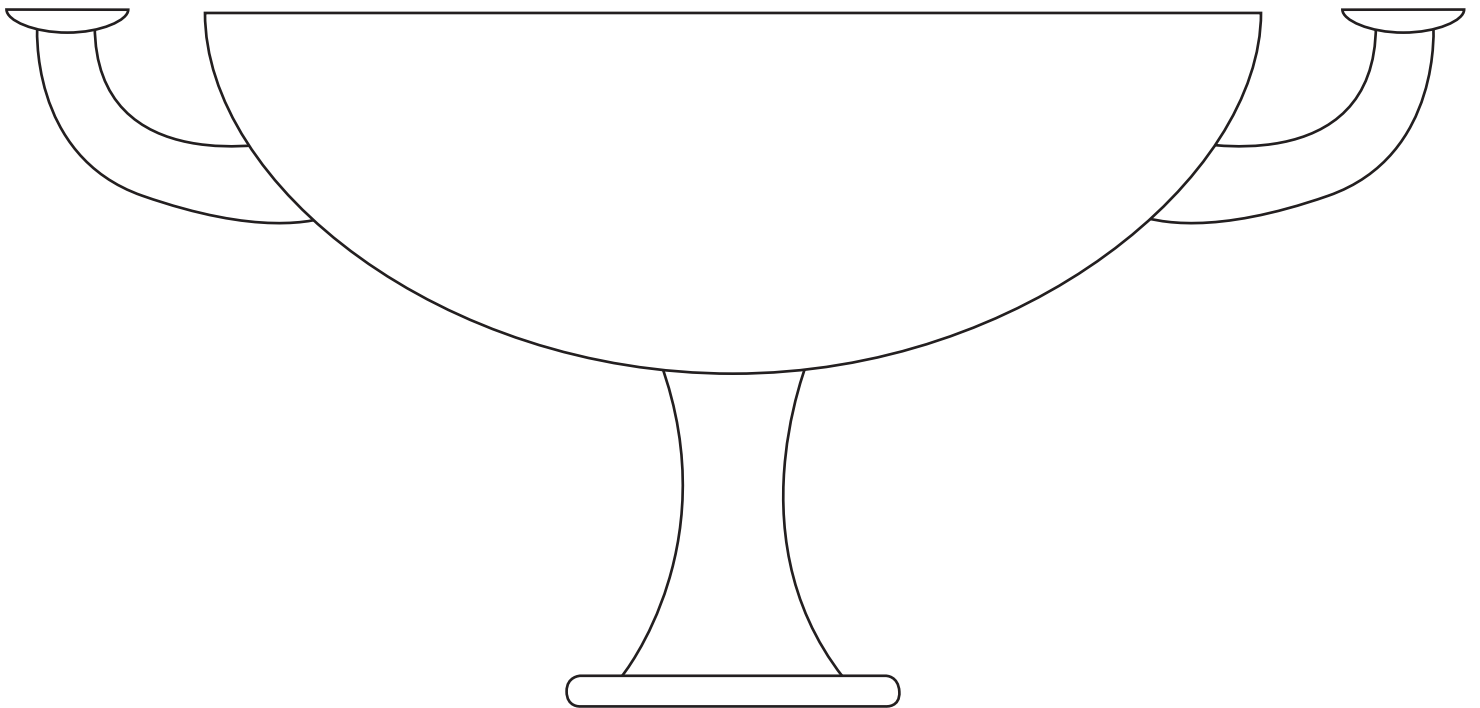
Amphora Vase



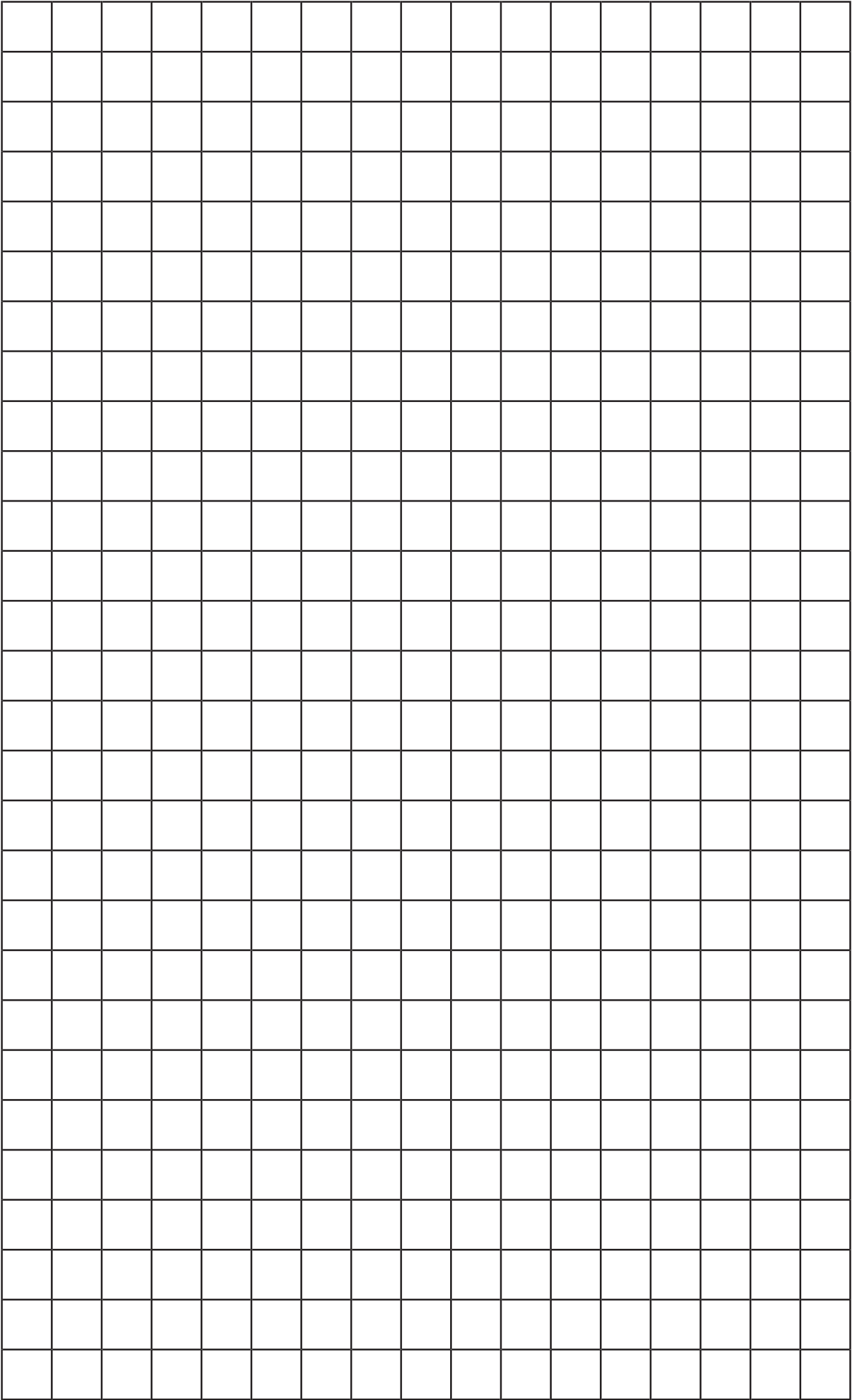
Two-handled vases, like this one, were used for storing and transporting wine or oil.
