

Krater Vase




Large vessels of this shape were used to mix wine and water for large gatherings.

Hydria Vase




Three-handled Hydria vases were used as water jars. The two side handles were used for lifting and carrying, while a larger third handle was used for pouring the water.

Amphora Vase



Two-handled vases, like this one, were used for storing and transporting wine or oil.

Kylix Vase



Shallow drinking cups with two handles were used during large gatherings. The wine and water mixture from a krater vase was ladled into individual kylix vases for drinking.
